Bill C. Campbell, 57, of Central City, died Friday, April 27, 2018 at UNMC in Omaha. Memorial services will be Friday, May 4, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. at the United Presbyterian Church with Rev. Doug McHargue and Rev. Beth Ann Stone officiating. Visitation will be Thursday, May 3, 2018 from 5 to 7 p.m. at Solt-Wagner Funeral Home in Central City.
