April 24, 1945 - March 18, 2018

Dale A. Carlson, 72, of Central City, Nebraska died Sunday, March 18, 2018 at Merrick Medical Center in Central City. Memorial services will be Thursday, March 22, 2018 at 4 p.m. at Solt-Wagner Funeral Home in Central City with Pastor Beth Ann Stone officiating. A reception will follow the Memorial Service at Solt-Wagner Community Room.

Dale taught school in Springview, Nebraska City, and Stromsburg. He taught Social Studies and English. When "he taught all he knew", he moved on to selling insurance, working for Modern Woodmen. The past twelve years, he finally found his dream job of doing maintenance and general crowd control at Bader Park. He worked several different jobs before landing this "dream". He would be smiling at this right now! He was a hard worker who never backed away from a challenge.

Dale was a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Central City, MU Epsilon of Lincoln, and the Liederkrantz of Grand Island. He loved making his grandma's sugar cookies.

Ian Tyson was a favorite writer and singer for Dale. Dale never got tired of listening to him.

He enjoyed visiting with friends "telling a short story in a long way", traveling, and spending time with family. Dale especially enjoyed hunting and birding with his grandson Carver.

Dale is survived by his wife Pat of Central City, NE; two daughters- Wendy Carlson and partner Angie Liske of Grand Island, NE; Heather and Brian Hauptman of Alliance, NE; two grandchildren- Carver Hauptman and Emma Liske; Uncle and Aunt- Bud and Dorothy Irwin of Central City, NE; several cousins.

He was preceded in death by his parents; father in law- Jim Stufft; mother in law- Ilajean Scherer.

Last month we had to bid a painful farewell to our friend, Dale Carlson, who passed away suddenly on Sunday, March 18. I could not help but think of the phrase “salt of the earth” in describing Dale. It is from the Gospel of Matthew, and is a metaphorical comparison to the importance and value of salt in the ancient world. A person said to be worth his salt was deemed worthy and dependable. Furthermore, it came to refer to one who was the best or most valued part of society. Today's common usage also includes descriptors such as decent and unpretentious. Dale was all of these things.

This is not to imply that Dale was angelic, and I'm sure he could have shared a story or two from his life to support this fact. The thing I appreciated most was his ability to be simultaneously humorous and serious about things. His acute observations about people and events were especially useful when relating stories about colorful characters known over a lifetime. Knowing his own mind as he did, Dale was never afraid to speak it. This trait garnered him respect in my eyes for being forthright and straight-up honest.


Dale loved the land, rural life, horses and livestock, many friends and family, and Bader Park, where he spent the past dozen years helping his wife, Pat (Bader Park Director), with all its substantial developments. He was a major force in the completion of the Dark Island Trail, and a friend of Prairie Plains.
