Dixie Lee Pierce Lovejoy, 75, of Hordville, Nebraska died Wednesday, August 28, 2024 at her home. Graveside services will be Sunday, September 1, 2024 at 11 a.m. at the Harvard Cemetery in Harvard, Nebraska with Trent Wagner officiating. Burial of ashes will be in the Harvard Cemetery.

In 1971, they moved back to Harvard and then to Hastings where the couple fostered some children for a couple years. Dixie did alterations for a few stores and eventually opened her own store, Dixie's House of Sewing. She moved to Florida for a year, then back to Harvard, and finally to Hordville, Nebraska where she worked at Champion Homes in York until her disability forced her to retire.

She married Ed Lovejoy in 1999. Ed passed in January of 2015.

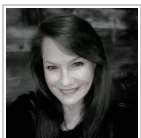
