Dorothy Marie Burger of Eau Claire, Wisconsin died March 13, 2023. Dorothy attended District #23 of Polk County for eight years and graduated from Silver Creek High School in 1940. She attended Nebraska Central College in Central City for one year and one summer. On June 29, 1941 she married Jack D. Burger at the Silver Creek Methodist Church. Dorothy was a big part of Jack's education career. She would host many get-togethers after ball games for school board members, teachers, family and friends. Also, she was matriarch for all sorts of family celebrations and gatherings. Dorothy was known for sending many cards of caring, encouragement, and concern to all. In her later years, Dorothy would use her lifeline, her phone, to keep in contact with all she knew. Therefore, Dorothy developed close ties with friends, neighbors, and family.

Dorothy was an active member of the United Methodist Women's Group joining at Clarks in 1941. She was a Sunday School teacher for more than 50 years and also routinely helped with summer Bible School.

She joined the Order of Eastern Star in September 1965 and was a member of Arbor Chapter #200. She was a member of the Kensington Club. She was appointed Grand Rep. OES on October 17 for 1978-1979 for the State of Nebraska.
