Edith D. Garrett, 67, of Central City, died on Thursday, July 8, 2021 at her home in Central City. Memorial services will be held on Tuesday, July 13, 2021 at 11 a.m. at Heartland Evangelical Free Church - South building, with Pastor J.J. Springer officiating. She attended school in Central City and graduated from Central City High School in 1972. Following her graduation she attended Grand Island School of Business. She then worked at a carpet store for a couple of years, before attending the University of Nebraska - Lincoln, where she graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Accounting.

On May 31, 1981, she married Bradley Garrett at the United Methodist Church in Central City. They then moved to Polk, and Edith began working in the accounting department at Flesher Manufacturing in Columbus. Edith later began working at ISS in Aurora. Eventually Brad and Edith moved to the

family farm near Central City. Edith decided to stay at home and take care of her children. After her daughters had grown, Edith began working at the extension office. After several years at the extension office Edith started an in-home daycare. She was able to keep the daycare open for several years, until her health would no longer allow her to work.

Edith attended the Heartland Evangelical Free Church in Central City. She enjoyed sewing, singing, cake decorating, crocheting, word searches, card games and her daycare children. Her greatest love was getting to spend time with her family, especially her grandchildren.
