Edith was a member of St. Boniface Catholic Church in Stuart, St. Michael's Catholic Church in Central City and Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Ord. She was also active with the American Legion Auxiliary and Christian Mother's in Stuart, Ord Alter Society, and Central City Catholic Ladies.

Edith and Bert were avid dancers. They especially enjoyed ballroom dancing. She also enjoyed knitting, crocheting, playing with photo printer, and baking pies and cinnamon rolls.
