During their married life, she raised the kids, gardened, canned, cared for her kids and was always there for them. She taught Sunday school & vacation bible school until she was no longer able to.

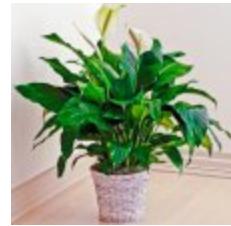
