Emerald Herman "Bud" Hansen, 92, of Hampton, Nebraska died Tuesday, August 28, 2018 at Westfield Quality Care in Aurora. A memorial service will be held at United Lutheran Church in Hampton on Saturday, September 1, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. with Pastor Miles Ruch officiating. There will be no visitation.

Bud was born on June 12, 1926 in York, NE to John Herman and Olga Marie (Madsen) Hansen. He was baptized on July 11, 1926, and confirmed May 12, 1943 at Immanuel Lutheran Church north of Hampton. He graduated from Hampton High School in 1943. He was proud to be a member of the 1942 State Basketball Team.

They lived in Lincoln, Hastings, and Grand Island, before moving to Hampton in 1963. Bud had many jobs over the years including – Omar Bakery, Allstate Insurance, Stan Allen Motors, Hampton Coop, Ericksen Sales and Service,

and was the custodian at the Hamilton County Courthouse until he retired in 1999. He was an active member of his church and held many offices. He loved playing golf and was an avid Husker football fan and Hampton Hawk supporter. He enjoyed having coffee with his friends at the C-Store.
