



## Genelle E. Erickson

February 17, 1921 - May 28, 2017

Genelle E. Erickson, 02/17/1921 to 5/28/17 was born: Angela Genelle Erickson, in Schuyler, Colfax County, Nebraska, to parents: mother, Rachel Marie Antoinette Eller (maiden name, Hannappel), born 11/19/1901, and Father, George Raymond Eller born 05/25/1895, who passed away when Genelle was thirteen. She had survived her three siblings: Marie Ann Haggerty, Alice Cason and George Eller.

Genelle married her high school sweetheart, Jerry (Gerald John Edwin Erickson), August 12, 1939. The newlyweds moved from Nebraska to Washington DC, and Genelle lived with Rachel during WWII while Jerry served in the Navy. After the war while still in D.C., Genelle and Jerry started a family. They have two daughters: Linda Ann born in 1946, and Maureen Kay born in 1949. Around 1950, they relocated to Los Angeles County, where Genelle worked as a Lockheed keypunch operator.

After moving to the San Francisco Bay Area in 1958 Genelle served as Executive Secretary in the Chief Pilot's Office, for Pan American Airways. During this time, the family traveled to Mexico, Central America, Europe and Africa.

She left Pan American ten years later, to relocate with Jerry, who worked for the U.S. State Department. They experienced two, 2-year tours, one in the

Philippines the other in Botswana, Africa. Once they both retired, Genelle and Jerry enjoyed traveling to Mexico with their trailer, and were “snowbirds” with homes in Arnold and Palm Desert, California.

Genelle and Jerry later moved to Santa Rosa, then in 2007, they relocated to San Clemente, near their daughter Maureen and her husband Barton. In July of 2014 Genelle and Jerry went to Seattle to live with their oldest daughter, Linda and her husband Robert. Jerry passed away on September 13, 2016.

Genelle is survived by her two daughters, Linda Erickson Knodle & Maureen Erickson Taylor; granddaughters- Natessa Evans & Katie Bronicki; grandsons- Robert Weaver, Damien Evans & Dan Sullivan; great granddaughter- Abbie Bronicki; great grandsons- Jacob Bronicki, Wyatt & Owen Sullivan.
