Gloria A. Clark, 87, of Central City, died Sunday, March 3 at Litzenberg Memorial County Hospital. Funeral services are Wednesday, March 6 at 11 A.M. at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Central City with Pastor Kevin McReynolds officiating.
