Ida was a woman of many talents and interests. She enjoyed bowling, crafts, painting, playing the organ, country music, dancing, cards, and bingo. Above all, her greatest joy was her family—spending time with her children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and great-great-grandchildren brought her endless happiness.

At the age of 13, Ida Mae was baptized and became a member of the First Baptist Church in Central City, where she accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior. In 1955, she joined the Methodist Church in Polk, where she

served faithfully in many roles over the years. She was Chairman of the Board, President of the United Methodist Women, and Chairman of the Funeral Committee for a decade. She also taught Sunday School, sang in the choir, and participated in countless church activities, sharing her faith and kindness with all who knew her.

In 2011, Ida moved to Lincoln to be closer to her family. Her warm spirit, positive energy, and genuine love for others made her a friend to everyone she met. She will be deeply missed by her family, friends, and those who lovingly cared for her.
