Irvin M. Beckstrom, 88, of York, died on Wednesday, December 23, 2015 at Bryan Medical Center-East, in Lincoln. Funeral services will be on Tuesday, December 29, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. at Solt-Wagner Funeral Home in Central City with Pastor Janet Burgel officiating. Irvin M. Beckstrom was born in Polk County on March 13, 1927 to Vernon and Lillie (Swedenburg) Beckstrom. Irvin grew up in rural Polk County and attended Stromsburg High School. In 1946 Irvin then began working for Dewey Anderson farming, and remained there until his retirement in 2007. On December 18, 1947, Irvin married Maxine Land. To this union they had four children. Irvin and Maxine remained in rural Polk County, until moving to York in 2013.

He enjoyed fishing, having coffee with his neighbors, and spending time with his family. He especially enjoyed spending time with his two grandchildren and his one great greanddaughter.

Irvin was a member of the Swede Plain Church, and also the Methodist

Church in Stromsburg. He was a past board member of the Stromsburg Co-Op, as well as the Swede Plain Cemetery.
