Kenneth W. Ziegelbein, 90, of Aurora, formerly of Polk, died Thursday, December 19, 2019 at Memorial Community Care in Aurora, Nebraska. 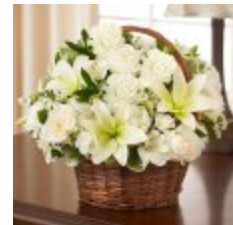

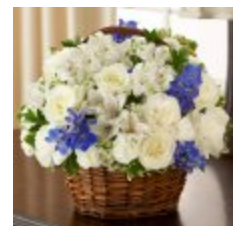
