



## LaVerna Orlea DaMoude

February 17, 1945 - October 18, 2020

LaVerna Orlea was born on February 17, 1945 in rural Palmer, to Elmer and Hulda (Bruns) Suck. LaVerna grew up in the Merrick County area, attending Merrick County grade school #43. She then attended Central City High School and graduated with the class of 1963. Following her graduation, she attended Mary Lanning School of Nursing, where she graduated with a Registered Nursing License. She then began working for Litzenberg Memorial Hospital until late 1968. On November 20, 1966 she married Leonard E. DaMoude at Archer Zion Lutheran Church in Archer. After they were married, LaVerna would stay home and help Leonard on the farm, and raise their two children, Kristine and Russell. LaVerna enjoyed crocheting and word find.

She was a member of the Fridhem Lutheran Church in Hordville, from 1973 until present, and while there she held various offices, part of the music and worship committee, as well as teaching Sunday School, and eventually becoming the Sunday School Superintendent. She was also a First Responder on the Hordville Volunteer Fire Department for 14 years.
