Lawrence C. Reeves, 86, of Central City, died on Monday, September 21, 2015 at Litzenberg Memorial County Hospital in Central City. He loved being on the lake and continued to work around the lake, as well as working with tractors, but his greatest love and enjoyment came from spending time with his family.
