Lela M. Frantz, of Warsaw and formerly of Nebraska, passed away unexpectedly at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne on Saturday, October 28, 2023, at the age of 78.

Lela was born in Sioux City, IA to Rolande Orvil Nielsen and Agnes Blanche (Couture) on September 25, 1945. She graduated from Cherry Creek High School in 1964 and from Baptist Bible College in Springfield, MO in 1968. Lela married Ronald (Keith) Musgrave on November 27, 1970.
