LeRoy loved the outdoors and one of his favorite things to do was going fishing. He loved to work in the yard and helped Jeanette with her flower garden.

LeRoy is survived by his wife- Jeanette of Central City, NE; two sons- Randy and Linda of Aurora, NE; Jon Kleve of Lincoln, NE; two grandchildren- Rachel Ann and Jackson; two sisters- Joan Craig of Orange County, CA, and Doris Dansby of Westminster, CA, and brothers Jerome and Verna Kleve of Fernly, NV, Danny and Carol Kleve of California, Larry and Diane Kleve of Phoenix, AZ, and many nieces and nephews.
