Malissa (Gregg) Dahlke, 43, of Genoa, formerly of Central City, died on Sunday, August 8, 2021 at Genoa Community Hospital – Long Term Care Center. Malissa wanted to get out as much as possible and was able to take her family to Walt Disney World, as well as Nashville, TN, and travelled on the back of a motorcycle as much as possible.

participated at the Huntington's Disease Research Centre in Wichita, KS. Those left to cherish her memory are her father, J. 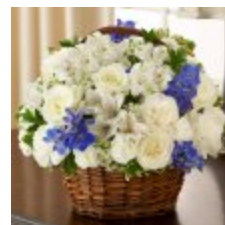
