Marvin D. Hablitzel, 89, of Lincoln, died on Wednesday, May 6, 2026 at Eventide Care Home in Lincoln. In 1994, they then moved to Bozeman, MT where Marvin ran his own company, repairing Mobile Homes, as well as working at Lowe's. Marvin retired in 2013 and moved back to Osceola until 2025, when they moved to Lincoln.

Marvin was always active, he enjoyed hunting, fishing, camping, and woodworking. He also enjoyed, country music, western movies, puzzles, and bowling. His greatest love was getting to spend time with family.
