Marvin G. Kyes, 80, of Central City, passed away peacefully Friday, March 16, 2018 surrounded by his family at Bryan West in Lincoln, Nebraska.

Marv served on the County Board, Fairgrounds Board, Rural Fire Department, and School Board. He was an avid sports fan, loved playing cards, and spending time with family. Marv always placed others before himself and was willing to help whenever someone was in need. He was a loving father, grandfather, and brother.
