Mary worked as a telephone operator for Clarks Telephone Company and Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company.

Mary worked for Central City Public Schools and Central Scale. She moved to Blair in 1979 and then later moved to Omaha where she worked for Paine Webber and later First National Bank of Omaha where she remained for 13

years until her retirement in 1998. Mary also kept busy working part time at the Westroads Hallmark Store and at Grandmothers Restaurant.

On May 27, 1995 Mary was united in marriage to Robert (Bill) Truesdell in Omaha. The couple eventually moved to Clarks in 1998. While living there Mary worked for J&J TV and Appliance as the bookkeeper. She sold Avon for five years and also worked in the kitchen cooking for High Plains Community Schools in Clarks.

Mary loved spending time with her children, grandchildren and other family and friends. She loved going to her grandchildren's activities. Mary enjoyed sewing, crafts, baking and playing cards. She was a member and officer of Parents without Partners in Grand Island and Omaha for 10 years. While at First National Bank of Omaha, Mary helped organized the Christmas Crafts Shows to raise money for needy families, was on the Quality Council Board for the merchant division, walked in Omaha's yearly corporate cup run/walk with the bank, and bowled on one of the women's teams for the bank.
