M. Maxine Teel, 90, of Central City, died on October 17, 2015 at Litzenberg Long Term Care in Central City. She especially enjoyed staying in Comstock with her daughter, Kathy, and her family, and developed many friends there. She and Lyle were especially close; particularly

in the final years of her life when he was always by her side and took care of her every need.
