Richard J. "June" Sealey, 91, of Polk, Nebraska died Tuesday, July 13, 2021 at Midwest Covenant Home in Stromsburg. Private Family Funeral services will be Saturday, July 17, 2021 at 10:30 a.m. at the Polk United Methodist Church with Pastor Neil Kloppenborg officiating. June was born on August 1, 1929 in Polk County to Richard C. and Agnes (Brown) Sealey. He grew up in the Polk area and graduated from Polk High School in 1946. He married Joyce Cramer on March 2, 1948 in Central City, Nebraska. The couple lived in Polk all their married life. June farmed most of his life but also worked for a time at the ASCS office in Osceola. One of his greatest passions was umpiring and refereeing. June traveled all over the Midwest refereeing and umpiring. He was even inducted into the Nebraska Baseball Hall of Fame for his umpiring.

June was a member of the Polk United Methodist Church and a member of the Masonic Lodge in Polk for over 60 years, and was the recipient of the Jordan Medal, as the oldest living member. He enjoyed golf and was a 4-H member in his younger years.

He is survived by his wife- Joyce of Polk, NE; two sons- Dennis and Becky Sealey of Sun Lakes, AZ; Richard L.
