Ron Erickson, 82, of Lincoln passed away on April 15th after a short battle with Liver Cancer. Born to Inez (Fullington) and Adrian Erickson. He grew up on a farm outside of Central City, graduating in 1959. Ron proudly served with the 295th regiment in Vietnam. His youth of service, created a man of service.
