Rosie was born on October 15, 1927 to Edward Michael and Mary Eleanor (Halstead) McMahon west of Central City in "Irish" town. She attended Central City Schools graduating from Central City High School in 1944. She then attended Nebraska Central College in Central City.

Rosie taught at District 39 school and married Joe Stanislav on February 22, 1946 in Central City. Rosie worked with Joe and was a homemaker. The couple lived on the farm northwest of Central City for 50 years, then to Aurora for 14 years, and then moved to Grand Island in 2009. Joe died on October 7, 2010.
