Sheila Lorraine (Carlson) Gulbrandson, 48, lost her battle with cancer at Methodist Hospital in Omaha, Nebraska on Saturday, October 10, 2015. Graveside services will be at 2 P.M. Thursday, October 15, 2015 at Swede Plain Cemetery with Pastor Willis Pauls officiating. Visitation will be Wednesday, October 14, 2015 from 6 to 8 P.M. at Solt-Wagner Funeral Home (South Location).
