Tom was born on November 29, 1950 to Darrell and Hazel (Marsh) Davis in Danbury, Iowa. Tom grew up in the Bellwood area attending school at Bellwood Elementary and graduating from David City High School in 1969. Tom became interested in being an auctioneer at the early age of thirteen, when he was a contestant on the game show "To Tell the Truth" in 1963. He was actually the youngest auctioneer in the United States at the time. He went on to be an auctioneer the rest of his life with a career that span over 50 years.

Tom married Susan Reichmuth on February 6, 1971 in Humphrey, Nebraska. The couple lived in Bellwood, Columbus, Clarks, and finally Central City. Tom and Sue owned and operated Davis Furniture and Auction Company for over 20 years in Central City.

Tom was a member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles in Central City. He enjoyed playing softball in his younger years. He was a huge fan of the Chicago Bears and the Nebraska Cornhuskers. Tom loved to play golf and repair old furniture. He also enjoyed fishing when he had the time. Tom and


