Bill was a huge Nebraska Cornhuskers fan, as well as the Kansas City Royals and New England Patriots. He enjoyed karaoke and dancing, and won many medals with the Special Olympics in bowling. One of his greatest enjoyments were getting to travel all over the United States with the group "Special

Journeys". Wherever Bill went people knew him and more importantly he would remember them by name.

Those left to cherish his memory are his mother, Sondra of Central City; his siblings, Laurie (Mark) Gansebom of Wayne, Rick Foulk of Grand Island, and Melissa (Ed) Mundt of York; and many aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, and cousins.

He was preceded in death by his father, Myron; nephew, Scott Gansebom; and sister-in-law, Teresa Foulk.
